Getting Life Ready is a Beaconsfield High initiative and our soft-skill or character development framework. It is the foundation upon which we will build remarkable learners and remarkable future citizens.

Teachers reference and signpost the specific GLR skills in lessons so that the girls will become adept at recognising in themselves their own strengths and areas for improvement. Skills include resourcefulness, risk-taking, resilience, reflection, creative and critical thinking and collaborative working. These skills will be implicit within all curriculum lessons for all, and they underpin our praise system.

Outside of lessons, we have a fantastic offering of co-curricular clubs and activities with over 120 happening on a weekly basis with over 100 students helping staff in the running clubs themselves. The clubs help build students' soft skills and you can see all our clubs on offer and how these links with our GLR skills. Many of the club's help develop students' soft skills and allow them to make friendships in other year groups.

In this booklet, you will find examples of some of the clubs on offer each week and a brief explanation for some these clubs. This is not all the clubs on offer, but a taste of what you can expect to enjoy here at Becky High!

Creative Thinking

Advanced Dance A	Our top auditioned dance club which works on different styles with a specialist dance teacher.
Cheerleading	Open to everyone, students will learn many aspects of cheerleading and put routines together.
Dance Live	Led by sixth formers, students will work to put together a performance including digital artwork, a narrative and designing costumes and make up.
GCSE & A-Level Art Drop -in	Art drop-in is there to further support GCSE and A level students outside of lessons. Art students can drop-in any lunchtime and have dedicated days with a staff member twice a week after school.
GCSE Dance Drop - in	Dance drop-in is there to further support GCSE students outside of lessons. It allows students the space to rehearse for their performance exam
GCSE Music Drop - in	Music drop-in is there to further support GCSE students outside of lessons. This is to support students with their composition outside of lessons.
Graphics Drop-in	Graphics drop-in is there to further support GCSE and A level students outside of lessons. Graphics students can drop-in any lunchtime and have dedicated days with a staff member twice a week after school.
Henna club	The Henna Club provides students with the opportunity to explore the cultural, artistic, and creative aspects of henna design. Members learn about the history and traditions of henna, develop practical skills in creating intricate patterns, and express their creativity through hands-on activities.
Knitting and Crochet Society	The Knitting and Crochet Society offers students the chance to learn and develop skills in these traditional crafts while exploring their creative potential.
Origami	The Origami Club introduces students to the art of paper folding, combining creativity with precision and focus. Members learn a variety of techniques to create models ranging from simple designs to complex structures.
Year 7/8 dance clubs	Open to all students in year 7 & 8, these clubs focus on lyrical and commercial styles of dance. They are led by the wonderful GCSE dance students under the guidance of Miss Brown.
Young Enterprise	Participating in Young Enterprise provides students with the life skills, knowledge and confidence they need to succeed in the changing world of work. Each team is responsible for making all their own decisions when setting up their own companies.

Critical Thinking

Art discussion society	The Art Discussion Society provides a forum for students to explore and debate a wide range of artistic movements, styles, and works. Members engage in thoughtful discussions, share perspectives, and develop critical thinking skills while deepening their appreciation of visual culture.
Bar Mock Trial	Prepares students for real life situations and careers in the legal profession. The competitions are run by the citizenship foundation; students take part in a mock trial in a real courtroom and compete against other schools.
Book Club	Chat about what you are reading and take part in quizzes, book related activities and treasure hunts! We take part in Carnegie, Bucks Book Award and much more!
Chess club	Any student is welcome to join us to play chess in a friendly and convivial atmosphere. It's also a great opportunity to learn new skills and tactics.
Coding Club	Coding Club is a fun and creative environment where we play with robots, do challenges, participate in online games and so much more. We always have chocolates and prizes so make sure you drop by!
Dungeons and Dragons Club	Dungeons and Dragons is a fantasy tabletop roleplay game set in a world of elves, magic and monsters. Will you defeat the dragon, gather as much gold as possible or befriend any animal you meet?
Film Club	Fascinated with film? Do you enjoy writing, fashion design, acting or filming? Film Club is the place for you! Here you'll plan, design, and create your very own original film, from start to finish.
Journalism Society	Students can write articles on any topic they are interested in and get help as much help as needed. We spend our time brainstorming concepts and typing up articles. We format then publish a finished newspaper in the student bulletin every half term.
Model UN	The club offers students the opportunity to simulate the United Nations, where students play the role of delegates from different countries and attempt to solve real world issues with the policies and perspectives of their assigned country. This enables them to hone their research and debate skills whilst broadening their understanding of the world and issues that impact us all.
Space Soc	Space Soc is a club where we discuss all topics related to space, from black holes to potential alien life within the universe. We also take part in fun activities every week, including space themed origami and building model rockets. We are open to any weekly topic requests and hope to see you there!
