



Year 9 & 10 Residential Trips - June 2027

Dear Parents/Carers,

Last academic year's Enrichment Week was a great success, with students taking part in a wide variety of activities and having memorable and meaningful experiences through residential trips, day trips and activities in school. We are looking forward to building on that success and providing another exciting programme of opportunities for our students in June 2027.

We are delighted to be offering four overseas residential trips to our Year 9 and Year 10 students in June 2027, as part of our previously published two-year programme of trips and enrichment opportunities. The trips available are:

- France
- Spain
- Battlefields
- Iceland

These trips will offer our students the chance to experience new places, cultures and activities beyond the classroom. None of these trips are curriculum essential they are an enriching experience to complement taught curriculums.

We anticipate that some trips could be oversubscribed. To help us plan effectively and allocate places as fairly as possible, we are therefore asking parents and carers to complete a short Microsoft Form, ranking the four trips in order of preference.

Please be aware that completing the form does not guarantee a place on a particular trip. Once we have received all responses, we will use the preference information to allocate places through a randomised allocation process. We will, where possible, also explore whether capacity on particularly popular trips can be increased.

Students are, of course, are not required to take part in a residential trip. An exciting and enjoyable programme of enrichment will be offered across the three Enrichment Days, either in school or through day trips, for students who do not take part in one of the residential opportunities.

There is no advantage to completing the form early, provided it is submitted by the deadline.

Once places have been allocated, we will contact families with confirmation and further details. A deposit will then need to be paid by the end of September via Scopay to secure the allocated place.

The anticipated deposits are:

- France – £200
- Spain – £200

- Battlefields – £150
- Iceland – £300

We hope that students are as excited as we are about the opportunities available. Enrichment Week is a wonderful chance for students to enjoy new experiences with their friends, and we are very much looking forward to another successful programme in June.
