Details of the Day

- Meet at **Hyde Park, Serpentine Bar and Kitchen** at **10:30** (nearest stations: Hyde Park Corner and Knightsbridge).
- Students will register with teachers on arrival. Usual attendance procedures apply, and parents/carers will be notified of any absences.
- The Treasure Hunt will begin shortly after registration and last around two hours.

Important Notes

- Please ensure your child is dressed appropriately for the weather (a jacket or raincoat if necessary).
- Students may bring a packed lunch or purchase food at the Serpentine Bar and Kitchen, though queues are likely with around 200 participants.

The event will finish at approximately **13:15**. After this, students may either:

1. Travel home independently with friends, or
2. return to Beaconsfield with a member of staff.
