



Year 10/11 Theatre Trip to Sadlers Wells to see “Hofesh Shechter’s Theatre of Dreams”

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to invite your child on an exciting trip I have planned for our Year 10 & 11 GCSE Dance students. I have managed to secure tickets to see the piece ‘Theatre of Dreams’ by the well-respected choreographer Hofesh Shechter at Sadlers Wells on Wednesday 15th October. We will be leaving **Beaconsfield Rail Station** around **17:00** and returning around **22.00**. The trip is priced at £33.00 including travel to and from the venue via train.

The piece is described by the theatre as follows: ‘this mesmerising work delves deep into the world of fantasy and the subconscious, revealing fears, hopes, desires and a web of emotions. Emotions that not only possess our dreaming minds but also our waking thoughts. From this uncontrollable wave of chaotic emotions and surreal events emerges a strange sense of clarity and reality’.

The trip will be a brilliant opportunity to inspire students with creative movement ideas for their own choreography and gain a deeper understanding of how dance skills should be applied in performance, a key aspect of the GCSE. Tickets will be live to purchase from Monday 22nd September and whilst the number we have is limited, I have purchased enough based on feedback from students who showed interest.

Students must gather outside the main entrance of **Beaconsfield Railway Station** wearing their school uniform by **17.00**. If they have a school jumper, then they do not need their blazer. However, if they do not have a school jumper then they must wear their blazer so that they can be easily identified in the theatre. Pick up will also be from the train station at approx. **22.00**, students will be asked to message home when we know the exact time of arrival.

Students may bring a small amount of money (I would recommend a maximum of £20.00) to purchase a Programme and/or refreshments.
