



Year 12 Lunchtime Privilege

Dear Parents/Carers,

From Monday 6th October all Year 12 students who are meeting the school's expectations for attendance, progress and behaviour will be granted the privilege of leaving the school site during lunchtime.

This is a significant step designed to foster greater independence, responsibility, and time management skills; all of which are vital for successful A-Level study and life beyond school. When students choose to leave the site, they are representing the school and are expected to maintain the highest standards of behaviour in our local community.

Students are responsible for their own safety when off-site at lunchtime. The school's duty of care applies only when they are on school grounds. It is the student's responsibility to return to school promptly before their afternoon lessons begin; lateness will affect their attendance record.

This is a privilege, not a right. It may be revoked immediately for any student failing to meet the required academic or behavioural standards.

We trust that students will manage this new level of freedom maturely, we encourage you to discuss this with them and reinforce the importance of safe conduct and punctual return to their studies. We appreciate your support in helping students manage this new responsibility.
