As you will be aware, your child is studying GCSE or A-Level Drama this year. To support students in their learning we have arranged for examination group students to have access to an online platform called Digital Theatre Plus. This site offers a range of recorded live theatre productions to watch. It also contains some essays/interviews/theatre criticism/lectures from respected teachers/directors/designers which are incredibly useful for the students for all aspects of the course.

We plan to use some of the resources as part of our teaching, and it will be particularly useful when preparing students for the Live Theatre Evaluation component of their written exam. Students can use the platform allowing independent access to all the productions and lecture notes from home at any time. It is an excellent resource with some challenging and though provoking productions available from companies such as the RSC, Frantic Assembly, The Lyric, National Theatre and The Old Vic.
