We would like to take our Graphics Designers on a trip to Harry Potter Studios in Leavesden on **Wednesday 4th February 2026**. As well as exploring the iconic sets and props from the films, students will take part in a **specialised Graphic Design workshop**, not available to the public, where they'll discover how professional designers played a key role in bringing the wizarding world to life — from creating spell books and potion labels to train tickets and other magical details. This hands-on experience will not only spark creativity but also highlight the wide range of career paths within the creative industries. By seeing how design is used in a real-world high-profile setting students will gain valuable insight, and a clearer understanding of how their skills can lead to exciting future opportunities.

We expect to leave school at around **08:30 and hope to return to school by 16:30** depending on traffic. Please arrange onwards travel as appropriate. We strongly suggest that students **bring a packed lunch** with them, although there may be the opportunity to purchase additional snacks at the café. Students may wish to bring a small amount of cash as we will be 'exiting through the giftshop'. Year 10 students are required to **wear school uniform for the trip** but may wear trainers if this is more comfortable for them. Year 12 students should wear appropriate clothing, adhering to the school's dress code.
