Dear Parents/Carers,

We are delighted to share that on **Wednesday 4 March 2026**, Beaconsfield High School will be hosting our first ever Community Iftar. This special event, held during Ramadan, will bring together students, staff, families and members of the wider community to share in the spirit of reflection, gratitude and togetherness. Everyone is warmly invited to attend, whether you are observing Ramadan or simply wish to learn more and be part of the occasion. The evening will include a short educational element, with students sharing what Ramadan and their faith mean to them, helping us to build greater understanding and connection across our community.

The idea for a Community Iftar was proposed by a group of Year 12 students. Their leadership reflects our commitment to student voice and our ongoing work in Equality, Diversity and Inclusion (EDI), and we are proud to support their vision.

What is Iftar?

Iftar is the moment at sunset when Muslims break their fast, traditionally beginning with dates and water before sharing a meal. It is a time for reflection, gratitude and community principles we are delighted to celebrate together at BHS.

A joint student-staff Planning Committee is leading the preparations to ensure the evening is respectful, safe and inclusive. We are now inviting support from our Becky High parent community and would appreciate any help you may be able to offer.

Ways You Can Help

- Professional halal catering: For health and safety reasons, all food must come from a certified halal caterer, so we are unable to accept homemade food. Recommendations or support in contacting caterers would be greatly appreciated.
- Donations of drinks & disposables: We welcome contributions such as bottled water, suitable soft drinks, and disposable plates, cups, cutlery and napkins (eco-friendly options encouraged).
- Décor and venue preparation: Donations of suitable decorations or support with setting up the venue on the day would help create a warm, welcoming atmosphere.
