We are pleased to be able to offer some revision sessions during the Easter break, between 30th March and 10th April. The sessions we are offering are based on teacher availability. Courses are full day, 10:00 – 15:00, unless otherwise stated. Please note that students **can't switch between subjects** during the day.

The cost of a whole day course is £49.50; the cost for a half-day course is £24.75. While these sessions can certainly be helpful for some students, I want to assure you that they are not necessary for your child to succeed. Our teachers are committed to providing a high-quality education for all students, and this takes place in lessons primarily. There are a vast range of drop-in sessions taking place at lunchtime and after school which run during term time, and we have no concerns about the time we have left in lessons.

That being said, we understand that some students may benefit from additional support and guidance during the Easter holidays. These revision classes will be taught by our experienced teachers who are familiar with the curriculum and are able to provide targeted instruction to help students reach their full potential.

If you feel that your child would benefit from these revision classes, we encourage you to sign up by paying for your chosen course via SCOPAY ([www.scopay.com/beaconsfield](http://www.scopay.com/beaconsfield)) by **09:00 Monday 2nd March**. Your payment will also serve as your parental permission for your child to attend.

Numbers will be limited due to classroom size, if we go over the limit, places will be allocated via a random ballot, or if there is not enough interest in a particular session then it may not be able to run.

Where Sixth Form students are entitled to 16-19 Bursary, we ask that the students make the payments out of the money received from the bursary.
