



### Thorpe Park Trip - Post-Exams Celebration

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are excited to inform you about an upcoming Year 10 trip to Thorpe Park, one of the UK's most thrilling amusement parks. We want to give the Year 10 cohort a trip to celebrate their brilliant work this year and to celebrate the completion of their upcoming internal exams.

The trip takes place on Friday 1<sup>st</sup> May, students need to arrive by 08:35 in the cafeteria for registration, departure at 09:00. We aim to be back at school by 17.30 (to be confirmed, but we will not arrive back in time for school bus departure).

There are two costing options for this trip:

- **All Inclusive Cost - £40.25**  
Which includes park admission, transportation, school insurance and supervision.
- **Merlin Pass Holder Cost - £22.25**  
This option is for students who **already have Merlin passes to Thorpe Park**. It is very important that if you choose this option that your child brings their pass with them. If not, we will pay their entry on the day and invoice you, but it will likely be more expensive overall as a result. This also includes transportation, school insurance and supervision.

If you would like your child to participate, in accordance with the school's charging and remissions policy, you are asked to make the voluntary contribution as above via SCOPAY ([www.scopay.com/beaconsfield](http://www.scopay.com/beaconsfield)) by **Wednesday 25th March**. (All payments are non-refundable unless we can replace your child's place on the trip).

Please note if there are insufficient contributions, the Visit/Trip may not take place.

Here is a list of essential items that your child should bring for the trip:

- Packed lunch and snacks or money to purchase food at the park.
- Appropriate clothing for the weather (considering the park's water rides).
- Comfortable shoes for walking.
- Sunscreen, hats, and sunglasses for sun protection.
- A fully charged mobile phone.

*(Please note lose items will need to be removed on the rides).*
