We are delighted to be welcoming Quantum Theatre to Becky High on Friday 13th March, to perform 'The Strange Case of Dr Jekyll and Mr Hyde' for our KS4 students. The text is a set text for the English Literature GCSE, and as such, we hope it will help prepare Year 11 for their upcoming public examination and give Year 10 an exciting taste of what is to come.

The production is entirely authentic to the book and mirrors exactly the book's structure. The play is presented as a mystery which is explained in statements at the end and the script is taken almost exclusively from Stevenson's own dialogue, interwoven with narrative passages from the book to tell the story. It will therefore be a fantastic opportunity to consolidate a complex but highly interesting text.
