2026 entry applications

- If you receive your last decision on or before **31 March 2026**, your reply date is **6 May 2026** (except if you're using Extra to find a place).
- If you receive your last decision on or before **13 May 2026**, your reply date is **3 June 2026** (except if you're using Extra to find a place).
- If you receive your last decision on or before **15 July 2026**, your reply date is **22 July 2026** (including Extra choices).

UCAS: Results Day Explained

- Meet firm offer = place confirmed
- Miss firm, meet insurance = insurance place
- Miss both = **Clearing**

- **Results Day is not a cliff edge.** There are multiple positive outcomes. Many universities still have spaces available, and students can speak directly with universities about suitable courses.

- **Students are not navigating it alone.** School staff will be available to support students with understanding their results and discussing next steps: **Clearing, remark requests, or alternative pathways.**
