



Classics & Latin Trip to the Ashmolean Museum

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to invite your child to attend the Classics & Latin Trip to the Ashmolean Museum on Monday 3rd November. This trip will give students an invaluable opportunity to study the fine detail of visual sources for which they have hitherto been reliant on photographs, including a plaster cast of the Prima Porta statue of Augustus, and to explore the wider artistic and material culture contexts of the literature that they are studying within the Latin and Classical Civilisation A level courses.

Students will travel together with myself and Mr Tu by train to Oxford from Beaconsfield train station. Students will leave school at 12:30, and we expect students to return to Beaconsfield train station by 19:15. We will ask each student to text their parents/carers the confirmed arrival time once they are on the return journey.

This educational visit is not a compulsory part of the school syllabus and is offered as an optional extra intended to complement the students' formal curriculum. If you would like your child to participate, in accordance with the school's charging and remissions policy, you are asked to make a voluntary contribution of **£14.25** via SCOPAY (www.scopay.com/beaconsfield) by no later than **Wednesday 22nd October 2025**. This payment will also cover the cost of a trip to the British Museum scheduled for Thursday 8th January 2026.

Please note if there are insufficient contributions, the Visit/Trip may not take place.

Where Sixth Form students are entitled to 16-19 Bursary, we ask that the students make the payments out of the money received from the bursary. If you are having difficulty meeting payment deadlines and wish to discuss a payment plan please contact trips@beaconsfieldhigh.school.
