



Year 7 Natural History Museum Science Trip 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to invite your child to take part in the 2026 Trip to The Natural History Museum. During the trip students will take part in a workshop involving classifying insects and evaluating the impact of insects on farming. They will also be taken around the Museum in their forms and fill in a worksheet relating the exhibits to their in-school learning. They will learn about a range of topics including evolution, classification and the structure of the earth.

Due to capacity for the workshops the trip will happen over two days, with students attending the trip on one of the days. Students will be expected in school attending lessons as normal on the day that they are not on the trip.

Further details about which day your child will be attending the trip will be communicated two weeks in advance.

This educational visit is a compulsory part of the school syllabus; the workshops and other activities will be linking to the in-school provision and the curriculum. As such all students will be expected to attend.
