The Spanish Department is delighted to announce the Year 12 Study Day Trip to the BFI in London, on Thursday 6th November 2025, focusing on Pedro Almodóvar's *Volver*. This study day will serve as an excellent introduction to the acclaimed Spanish director and will include an exploration of key themes and stylistic features, structured in line with the AQA and Edexcel A Level specifications.

Students will be accompanied by myself and will travel by train from Beaconsfield station to London Southbank. Departure from school is scheduled for 08:30, with an estimated return to Beaconsfield station at approximately 17:00. Students will be asked to text parents/carers with a confirmed arrival time during the return journey.

This educational visit is optional and is designed to enrich students' formal curriculum. If you would like your child to participate, please reserve a place by making a payment of £40.00 via SCOPAY (www.scopay.com/beaconsfield) no later than 1 October 2025.

Please note that the cost does not include train travel or meals. Students will therefore need a valid travel card for the train and London public transport, as well as sufficient funds or a packed lunch for the day.
