In preparation for the upcoming GCSE and A-Level Component 1 submission, we will be running a Sunday workshop on Sunday 30th November 2025 from 09:00 until 15:00 for both Art and Graphics students.

In recent years our weekend workshops have been highly valued by all the students and a great success with students completing a huge amount of work. The session equates to roughly three weeks of lesson time, so is an opportunity not to be missed.

On the day students will have access to the department and specialist materials and equipment, which they will not have at home, and it will also give students additional time with their teachers to discuss their final pieces and to complete their documentation work.
