### Sixth Form Applications

Applications to Becky High Sixth are managed through an online platform called Applicaa. Students should have received an email earlier this week with their login details and a link to their application form. If this has not been received, please contact [sixthform@beaconsfieldhigh.school](mailto:sixthform@beaconsfieldhigh.school). Students will be asked to submit their preferred A-Level subject choices. The **application deadline is 09:00 on Monday 23rd February 2026**.

### Entry Requirements

Students must achieve a minimum of 46 points from their best 8 GCSEs, including:

- GCSE Maths and English Language or Literature at Grade 5 or above
- The minimum GCSE grade requirements for their chosen A-Level subjects

All students study at least three A-Levels. Students achieving 64 points or more may be eligible to study four A-Levels; however, this pathway is highly demanding and can place considerable pressure on workload, even for very able students.

### Subject Availability

While every effort is made to accommodate students preferred subject combinations, this cannot always be guaranteed due to timetabling or demand. Where a student's initial choices cannot be offered, we will provide individualised support and guidance to help them select suitable alternatives aligned with their strengths and future aspirations.

**Enrichment Programme**

Students will also participate in an enrichment programme, which may include the EPQ, Duke of Edinburgh's Award, Sports Leaders, Young Enterprise, elite sport, graded music, dance or theatre qualifications, language learning, or a regular volunteering commitment. Preferences will be submitted when students join the Sixth Form in September.

We very much look forward to welcoming your child to Becky High Sixth and continuing to support them as they progress into the next stage of their education.
