



Enrichment Opportunities – June 2026

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to make you aware of an exciting enrichment program taking place over three days, from **Wednesday 17th to Friday 19th June 2026**. You do not need to sign up at this stage; this letter is simply to inform you of what is planned.

During these three days, **all Year 10 students will be off timetable**, to allow them to participate in a range of enriching activities.

We are planning four enrichment options:

France (Paris)

Residential Trip run by the French team, open to students studying French.

Spain (Santiago de Compostela)

Residential Trip run by the Spanish team, open to students studying Spanish.

History (Battlefields)

Residential Trip run by the History team, open to students studying History.

Other Program

Non-international activities in and around the school, possibly including London. The exact program will be confirmed once we know student numbers not taking part in the international trips above.

Please note:

- Previously, the Spanish and French trips have been 4-night residential. The battlefields trip has been a 2-night residential.
- Costs are to be confirmed, but students eligible based on subjects studied will be contacted in due course with details and an offer of a place on the relevant trip. For reference, these three trips which ran in 2025 were costed at: Spain: £850.00, History: £562.00, France: £855.00.

For students not taking part in an international trip, the expectation is for them to be in school for the three days of enrichment, taking part in the planned activities. We will kindly be asking for a recommended donation amount to support this option, as we aim to make the enrichment experience accessible to all students in a cost-effective way.

The aim of these enrichment days is to provide students with meaningful experiences and opportunities to develop skills and knowledge outside the classroom, while still ensuring that their studies are supported in the lead-up to the GCSE year. Further details, including confirmed programs, costs, and how to register, will follow in due course. Thank you for your support, and we look forward to offering students an engaging and memorable enrichment experience in June.
