



Mobile Phone Pouch Update: Year 7-9

Dear Parents/Carers,

We are pleased to inform you that the phone pouches have now arrived in school. The relevant area of the Behaviour for Learning Policy will therefore go live from Monday 3rd November. On this date, pouches will be handed out to students during form time, and from then, all Year 7–9 students will be expected to secure their phones in their pouches upon arrival at school. The pouches will remain locked until the end of the school day.

Every student will need their phone pouch in school every day. For students in Years 7–9, any smartphones brought into school should be switched off and will be locked and stored in a phone pouch at the start of the day and unlocked at the end. Students will store the pouch in their bag or locker for the duration of the school day.

Any student who has not yet purchased a phone pouch will be required to hand in their phone to the Pastoral Hub each morning and collect it again at the end of the day.

If you have not yet purchased a pouch, please do so via SCOPAY (www.scopay.com/beaconsfield) as soon as possible at a cost of £12.50 per pouch.
