



June Enrichment - Spanish Trip to Santiago de Compostela

Dear Parents/Carers,

The Languages Department are delighted to announce the Year 10 residential trip to Santiago de Compostela, from **Wednesday 17th June 2026 through to Sunday 21st June 2026**. This will be a fantastic opportunity for students to practise their Spanish, see the sights, and immerse themselves in Spanish culture.

Students will stay in a Hotel in Padrón, and some of the activities that they will be taking part in are:

- Visit to Santiago de Compostela's Old Town with a guided visit to the Cathedral.
- Walk a 15k stage of the "Camino de Santiago" with arrival to the Santiago's Cathedral.
- Boat trip to Ons Islands National Park.

The cost of the trip will be approximately £940.00 per person. Once final numbers participating are confirmed, the cost will be fixed. This will include half board accommodation for 3 nights, and bed & breakfast accommodation for 1 night. Lunches are not included in this price so students will need to bring £15.00 per day with them to purchase these.

If you would like your child to participate, in accordance with the school's charging and remissions policy, you are asked to make a voluntary contribution of **£150.00** via SCOPAY (www.scopay.com/beaconsfield) as a deposit by **Sunday 16th November**.

Please note if there are insufficient contributions, the Visit/Trip may not take place.
