If you pass the tickets on to another family, please notify Mrs Craggs of this, so we can ensure our ticket list is accurate for fire safety.

We will be operating a waiting list for tickets so if you are unable to purchase a ticket via the link above, please contact Mrs Craggs who will add you to the waiting list and contact you should a ticket become available. Please do not turn up on the evening of the concert without a ticket as you will not be admitted.

Refreshments will be available to purchase before the concert and during the interval. These are kindly provided by the Bel Canto committee, and you will hear more information about this group during the concert.

Evening Arrangements

Students should arrive at 18:00 ready for a warmup in the hall. They will register in their allocated classroom and prepare for the evening. Students should be wearing their house t-shirt along with black trousers/ or leggings with their school shoes.

We estimate that the evening should finish by 20:15, so if you are unable to attend, students need to be collected from reception at this time.
