



Theatre Trip Cabaret

Dear Parents/Carers,

The Drama Department would like to take the Year 10, 11, 12 and 13 GCSE/A level Drama students to see Cabaret on the afternoon of Wednesday 3rd December 2025. The Year 11 students will write about this performance for Section B of their GCSE Component 3 examination which is worth 10 % of their GCSE grade.

For Year 10, 12 and 13 students the production will support their understanding of design elements and integrally support aspects of the written examination. We want students to see as much live theatre as possible to prepare them for their written examinations and having the opportunity to see this production at the reduced student rate is a valuable learning opportunity for them.

We will leave school at 12:00 and travel via coach, students should wear school uniform. Yr12s and 13s should follow their 6th form uniform policy. We expect to arrive back at school around 18.00. The students will need to bring a packed lunch.

If you would like your child to participate, in accordance with the school's charging and remissions policy, you are asked to make a voluntary contribution of £50.50 via SCOPAY (www.scopay.com/beaconsfield) by **20th October 2025**. This covers the cost of the ticket and the coach to and from London.
