We are delighted to share that Onatti Theatre Company will be visiting our school next week on **Monday 16th March** to perform a live play titled *Un ensayo desastroso* for all our Year 8 and Year 9 Spanish students.

Onatti Theatre Company is a well-established educational theatre group that specialises in producing modern, engaging plays performed entirely in foreign languages that students are learning. Their work is specifically designed to bring languages to life, make learning memorable and support classroom study by blending entertainment with language practice.

The play "*Un ensayo desastroso*" is performed in Spanish, tailored to the age and level of our students, and tells the story that happens in a "small-town" in Spain where auditions are taking place for their new production of *Romeo y Julieta*. This play offers lots of opportunities for language comprehension and cultural exposure. The performance is interactive, and students may be invited to take part in scenes or activities during the show.

In preparation for the visit, students have already begun practising some lines in their Spanish lessons and exploring elements of the play. We hope many of them will be excited to join in and contribute to the performance if invited.
