



### Virtual Year 9 Parents' Evening

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to invite you to attend our Virtual Year 9 Parents' Evening on **Thursday 5th March 2026**, from 15:00 - 18:30, where you will be able to discuss your child's progress, with a range of subject teachers. Please note that some appointments will be available to book outside of these times, due to the need for flexibility for some teachers.

Appointments will be held online and last five minutes each. Once booked, you will receive an email confirming your appointments. We aim to ensure that all parents/carers have an opportunity to book an appointment for core subjects: English, Maths and Science. Please note there will be a limit of **8 appointments per student** between both parents/carers not each, which includes the core subjects. Should your appointments exceed this quota they will be adjusted to 8.

We give teachers the option of requesting a meeting with certain students' parents/carers, if they think this will be particularly beneficial, these appointments will be automatically generated, and you will receive confirmation of the appointment. If you then wish to change the reserved appointment time, you will be able to do this when the system goes live.

We would like to reassure you that if teachers had any concerns, they would be proactive about contacting you, rather than waiting until Parents' Evening. There is lots of information on our new website about [our curriculum](#), so you can better understand what your child has been learning this year, and how knowledge is built throughout the key stage.

**Please note the following** if relevant for your child. To create more capacity:

- For **Science**, staff will be taking specific classes to discuss either one, two or all three subjects, when you go online to book you will be able to see the teacher allocation for your child. This will enable us to ensure every parent/carer can book an appointment with a minimum of one teacher.
- **Technology**: If you consider **Graphics or Food** as one of your Options, you will be able to select Graphics or Food for an appointment, even if you do not have that technology class at present.
- We do not offer GCSE **Textiles** but please do book an appointment if you wish to discuss your child's progress.
- For other subjects, please be aware several teachers teach more than one class, we ask you therefore to only book an appointment if you have a concern. **Please prioritise your option subjects where possible.**
- If you are unable to book an appointment, please add yourself to the waiting list.

#### How to book your appointments:

The booking system will open on **Monday 23rd February from 19.00** and will close on **Sunday 1st March at 23.55**. To book your appointments go to: <https://beaconsfieldhigh.schoolcloud.co.uk/>.
