



RS International Trip to Prague

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to gauge your interest in a new RS trip to Prague, which will take place at the very start of October half-term (Wednesday, 21 October until Friday, 23 October 2026). It is important to note that the choice of travel to Prague is via plane, meaning we will get almost three full days.

This educational trip offers the chance for our students to immerse themselves in the multi-faith society of eastern Europe. They will have a chance to explore the Christian and Jewish past of Prague, focusing specifically on how two different religious traditions could co-exist and thrive throughout the centuries: our visits include a tour of the Jewish Museum and the world-renowned Jewish cemetery, and the medieval Prague Castle and Strahov Monastery with its Theological and Philosophical Halls. At the same time, the students will also reflect on themes of oppression and resistance: these will be particularly perceived in the visit to Terezin, a Nazi ghetto/concentration camp which saw the Jewish community react in non-violent ways to persecution.

The trip is open to our current Year 9's, 10's, 11's and 12's who will be in Year 10, 11, 12, and 13 at the time of the trip. The cost of the trip will be around £900.00 (with costs potentially reducing even further, the more participants sign up) this includes:

- Transfers between the school and a London airport (tbc).
- Transfers to/from Prague Airport to Prague Centre, and to/from Prague to Terezin.
- Accommodation.
- Entry tickets to all museums (including some guided tours).
- Travel Insurance.
