



Disneyland Paris – Computer Science & Business Studies Trip

Dear Parents/Carers,

We would like to invite your child to take part in the 2027 joint Computer Science and Business Studies Trip to Disneyland Paris. The event aims to bring the Computer Science and Business curriculum to life with a half-day conference (separate and specific to each subject) hosted at the Disneyland & Walt Disney Studios Parks. It has strong links to curriculum and discussions around careers in their respective industries. We will be using the tour company European Study Tours, who have run this trip with us very successfully in the past, most recently in 2024, 2025 and 2026.

This trip is being offered to those currently in Year 9, who at the time of the trip will be in Year 10 and studying either Computer Science or Business Studies. We reserve the right to remove any young person from the trip who is not taking either of these subjects to GCSE level. Joining this optional trip is also subject to good attendance and behaviour.

For Computer Science, this trip is intended to improve students' understanding of Computer Science in the wider world. It will cover themes including Programming, Animatronics, Robotics, Cyber Security and Ecommerce.

For Business Studies, this trip is intended to improve students' understanding of Strategy, Marketing, E-commerce, Globalisation, Sustainability, Corporate and Social responsibility and Decision making.

For students who are planning to take both subjects, we will ask them closer to the time which conference they would prefer to attend. The details of the trip are as follows:

To: Disneyland Paris
Date: Saturday 20th February 2027 to Tuesday 23rd February 2027
Departure: From school, late Saturday evening. Overnight coach and ferry/tunnel or train TBC.
Hotel : Explorers Hotel (50 Av. de la Fosse des Pressoirs, 77700 Magny-le-Hongre, France) TBC.
Return: To school on Tuesday, likely early evening. Daytime coach and ferry/tunnel back. *
Cost: £780.00. (which includes costs for all transport, park admission (2 days), conference, hotel, all food, insurance, and a trip hoodie)

** Students will be expected to return to lessons, as normal, on Wednesday morning.*

We will have capacity to take up to 40 young people on this trip, in the last 3 years we have been able to take all the students that wanted to go and had completed the expression of interest form. We kindly ask you to complete this year's expression of interest form, the deadline for completion is Sunday **12th April**.

We will draw names from this on Monday the 13th April. Those without a place will form a reserve list. If a place is offered to you, and no deposit payment is made by the 19th of April, we will assume you no longer wish for your young person to join the trip, and the place will be given to the first person on the reserve list.

As this is an international residential trip, you will need to be responsible for ensuring your child has a valid passport to visit France (Expires **after 1st June 2027** at the earliest).
