The Science department is pleased to invite your child to take part in a trip to the Oxford University Botanic Gardens and Museum of Natural History. The Trip will take place on July 1st, 2026. The students will have the opportunity to take part in a workshop on biodiversity and evolution run by the education team at the museum as well as explore the range of exhibits. They will also visit the botanic gardens which contain a fantastic variety of plants representing the adaptations they are studying in class. This trip will be a fantastic supplement to their study of biodiversity and evolution.

Students will be taken around in 2 groups and are expected to complete a worksheet provided by the school.

This educational visit is not a compulsory part of the school syllabus and is offered as an optional extra intended to complement the students' formal curriculum.

Students will meet at school at 08:40 and we will take the coach to the museum and return before 15:30. Students will be expected to bring a packed lunch and be dressed sensibly as there will be a lot of walking involved. They will also need to bring a pen and a notebook.
