



MANAGED DEVICE SCHEME

At Beaconsfield High, we have high expectations of all our students, and we believe access to technology supports and empowers them to manage their learning, by being independent and being able to conduct their own research. For this reason, every student joining BHS is required to purchase a uniform device via the schools' managed device scheme.

For the third year, we will be offering a managed device scheme, and the transition team will provide you with access to a portal when it's time to place your order. The device will be delivered to school, and your child will take delivery during the autumn term. You will have the option to purchase it outright or to rent or pay in instalments.

Why does BHS offer a managed device scheme?

- The use of computers has become the norm in society and at BHS we desire to embrace the increasing digital opportunities to students in education.
- Our device scheme aims to provide all students with equal access to digital learning and the benefits that can be derived from it.
- Students are required to have a device in school and often turn in their homework online. The scheme also aims to reduce the pressure on devices at home.
- All Year 7 children joining us are required to have a standardised laptop device which is specifically configured for use at BHS. Doing so enables the best possible digital learning for your child.
- The device we have chosen has proved to be a reliable and robust, which allows equality of learning throughout the school.
- Our current provider is Easy4U (Class Technology Solutions Ltd) who provide a variety of payment plans, making it accessible for all students to have a standardised device. Currently, payment plans start from as little as £13.30 per month depending on the duration of the payment plan. You will receive the update to date information once your child is offered a place at our school.

The benefits of a managed device scheme:

- A reliable device chosen to withstand the rigours of school life.
- Peace of mind as there is insurance available.
- Seamless learning if the device should develop a fault (the device would be swapped over at school for a loan laptop whilst your device is being fixed).
- The school's safeguarding and monitoring software will also be loaded onto the laptops before we take delivery of them.
